

# TRAVELING TO ORVIETO...

## What you need in your suitcase

- Clothes for the season. Winter is cold (but not snowy), spring is nice, summer can be very hot, and fall is a lot like spring.
- 2-3 chef's jackets. You will receive a nice Zeppelin chef jacket when you are here.
- Bring your knives if you wish, of course, in the checked luggage! (Chef knife, paring and boning is sufficient.)
- Electronics: Italy has 220 volts and you need a voltage converter for your electronics. You can find these at the airport or any electronics store in the US.
- Good walking shoes. We are going to walk, and sometimes a lot ...

## What you need in your wallet/purse

- Your school ID
- Your PASSPORT!!!
- Euros. Do not change a lot in the USA, they probably won't give you a great deal. You can use local ATMs, or exchange dollars to Euros at the Post Office here in Orvieto.
- Your health card, if applicable. Hospital is basically free here and you are covered by insurance. If for any reason you have to visit the hospital, they will ask for your "health story" and if you have something to be monitored. Don't worry, you will be fine!

## Your house in Orvieto

Accommodations are located about 10-20 minutes walking distance from Zeppelin Restaurant. The address for Zeppelin is:

If you have family/friends coming to visit and they need an accommodation we have special rates available at Piccolomini Hotel, next door to where Zeppelin is located. Guests are not allowed at the student residences.

## Flying to Italy

**Flight fares are not included in the program, so you have to arrange your travel to Italy.**

You will fly to Rome airport Fiumicino (FCO), arriving on Sunday, the first day indicated on the program schedule. Choose flights arriving between 7:00am – noon, so we can collect all the students and transfer to Orvieto in our vans.

**You DO NOT need require any Visa if you are a US citizen. If not a US citizen, you will need to check your country's travel requirements.**

## Meeting Point

We meet you at Terminal 3 Fiumicino Airport, International arrivals. After you retrieve your luggage, walk toward the "Nothing to Declare" area through the exit doors. Upon exiting, you will see a pillar with the sign "MEETING POINT" and a caffè named "Vacanze Romane." We will be there to meet you!
